

Scout Soapbox Derby for Diabetes: Rules

This soapbox derby race is all about fun and creativity. There is no need to spend a lot of money on an expensive kit. We encourage you to create your own unique car. Sponsorship is allowed and encouraged. Your sponsor can donate parts, money for parts, or even money for your entry fee. Each car can hold from one to four racers. Themed cars are encouraged (ex: Batmobile or Speedracer). Costumes are welcome (or scouts can wear their uniforms if they prefer). Keep your designs safe and drivable. You should have some type of braking system and steering system. The course will be a closed street road that is mostly straight with a slight angle. Please limit your turning radius to prevent over correcting and crashes. Cars will be judged on creativity and showmanship. Remember, be creative, safe, and let's have some fun!

All applications need to be turned in with payment of \$20.00 by 4-1-2010

All racers must wear: a helmet, knee pads, elbow pads, and a mouth guard.

Open to all Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts.

Limit of 4 racers per car.

Cars must be human powered only-no engines of any type.

Cars maximum length: 12 feet

Car maximum width (from wheel to wheel): 4 feet

Car maximum height: 6 feet

Car maximum weight 200lbs with driver(s).

Cars must have a braking system.

Cars must have a steering system.

Seating position to be upright, facing forward, and feet first.

All racers under the age of 18 must have an adult present at the time of the race.

All racers must sign a release of liability form.
